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Project Title: Perris Valley Line (PVL)

Project Description (Additional Page):

To address regional mobility issues, RCTC proposes to extend commuter rail service approximately 24 miles into the Interstate 215 (I-215) corridor in western Riverside County. This new commuter rail service, known as the PVL, would be an extension of the SCRRA/Metrolink 91 line from the existing Riverside Downtown Station along a three mile segment of the Burlington Northern Santa Fe (BNSF) main line and would connect to the San Jacinto Branch Line (SJBL) with the proposed Citrus Connection. The Citrus Connection will construct a new curved rail segment that connects the BNSF to the SJBL for approximately 21 miles extending south to the City of Perris.

Project features include:

- Construction of four ADA compliant commuter rail stations;
- Construction of a new rail segment (Citrus Connection) between the BNSF and SJBL;
- Replacement and rehabilitation of existing rail and railroad ties, as necessary;
- Installation of track for a future Maintenance-of-Way Facility;
- Installation of a new bypass track along a portion of the I-215 corridor;
- Construction of a Layover Facility;
- Replacement of two existing bridges over the San Jacinto River and San Jacinto River Overflow Channel;
- Culvert replacement at designated locations;
- Construction of nine communication towers;
- Construction of three landscape walls at selected locations;
- Improvements and closures of existing at-grade crossings along the SJBL; and
- Street improvements at designated locations.

RCTC anticipates that the PVL would become operational in late 2012.
